Dear Commissioners:

We have reviewed a copy of the Interim Report concerning the proposed changes in the Electoral Boundaries.

We are disappointed that we have been separated from O'Leary. We feel we are, in effect, losing our representation on the Provincial level.

Currently Eva Rodgerson lives in O'Leary and with the new boundaries we will be lumped into the Alberton area. We feel as though we would be cut off from our provincial representative due to the distance.

West Point is part of the South Shore, fall fishing season and Alberton is on the North Shore which has the spring fishing season. We feel this could hurt people involved here in the fishery industry.

At this time tourism is experiencing a low and we feel a representative from the Alberton center may not represent our cause as well as a representative from the O'Leary center would. Both now and in the future.

We understand that the total number of provincial representatives will not change but we do feel that we would get less support being a part of the Alberton center as compared to being with the O'Leary center.

We understand the complexities of changing this Interim Report and that this one little letter wouldn't carry a lot of weight with your Commission, but we want to register our feelings on this issue.
